- Provide a Curriculum Vitae
- Submit short essay (up to 1,000 words maximum) discussing one or a combination of the following:
 - How you expect to benefit from attending the 2020 Charleston Library Conference virtually? How has the current climate affected your outlook on your work with the library community?
 - If you've previously attended, what have been the key takeaways and how have you applied them in your current professional role?
 - How do you see online products focused on the Humanities and Social Sciences evolving as universities shift toward digital learning?

Applicants must be employed by an academic library.
